3. Approve Minutes of the May 14, 2019 Transportation TAC meeting

4. 2020-2025 Surface Transportation Program (STP-Urban) Grant

Discussion: Included in the meeting packet is a set of guidelines for the 2020-2025 Surface Transportation Program Grant application. The funding is from FHWA and WisDOT for the Wausau Area Metropolitan Planning Organization projects with allocated funds of approximately \$2.4 million during this upcoming cycle. The amount reflects the North 6th St. project in the City of Wausau was allocated in the last cycle for approximately \$650,000 and counts against the total of \$3.1 million. The final allocation number will be known once the state budget is finalized. The projects that can be submitted for funding are roads functionally classified as arterials or collectors. The draft applications are due to WisDOT by early September.

5. STP-Urban Project Selection Criteria

Discussion: Lynch addressed issues discussed from the last meeting.

- Safety Component – safety conditions would receive a score from the crash calculation.
- Environmental Justice – a project located in a minority or low income area will receive a point. This is designed to make sure these areas are not neglected for road improvements.
- The Weight System - key component and safety are 20%, system condition and multimodal 15%, freight and project coordination 10%, and congestion and environmental justice 5%.




