

40 Q: Oh you know what I'm gonna grab - be right with you, Dylan, okay? Right?

42 tore into those. I keep forgettin' - I need one more thing. I really apologize.
43 Hang on a second. Be right back, okay?

47 Q: Just me. Oh okay. It's Dylan, right?

49 A: Huh?
50
51 Q: It's Dylan, your first name. Okay. Dylan, so again, my name's Todd and
52 before we go any further kinda the scope of what we're dealing with here and
53 everything that went down tonight. I want to make sure we're all on the same
54 page so I do have to read you these rights here.
55
56 A: Mm-hm.
57
58 Q: Um, and I'm just gonna go through 'em one - kinda one sentence at a time and
59 just check off that I've read 'em to you. Afterward I'm gonna ask that you
60 sign just indicating that I read them to you...
61
62 A: Mm-hm.
63
64 Q: ...and then I'll ask you a couple questions after that, okay?
65
66 A: Mmm.
67
68 Q: So first of all you have the right to remain silent. Anything you say can be
69 used against you in court. You have the right to talk to a lawyer for advice
70 before we ask you any questions and to have him or her present during
71 questioning. If you cannot afford a lawyer one will be appointed for you
72 before any questioning if you wish. If you decide to answer questions now
73 without a lawyer present you'll still have the right to stop answering at any
74 time. You also have the right to stop answering at any time until you talk to a
75 lawyer. So what this says right here - it just says that I have read or have had
76 read to me this statement of my rights, which I just read you, and I understand
77 what my rights are. No promises or threats have been made to me. No
78 pressure or coercion of any kind has been used against me. If you agree with
79 that you can go ahead and sign right there.
80
81 A: The date is the, ah...
82
83 Q: The 22nd today, right? Let me just 2-27.
84
85 A: Two...
86
87 Q: Yeah, 2-27-15. Now I will sign right here. So now right here, do you
88 understand each of those rights, yes?
89
90 A: Ah, these?

91
92 Q: Yes, do you understand each of the rights that I read to you?
93
94 A: Mmm.
95
96 Q: Okay. Kinda need a verbal, is it yes or no?
97
98 A: Ah, to be honest kinda not really.
99
100 Q: I can read 'em again. I mean we go through them again so you...
101
102 A: Well, I know - I know these. It's just the lawyer part I don't get.
103
104 Q: Okay. It just says, ah, you have a right to talk to a lawyer before we ask you
105 any questions and to have them with you during questioning. If you can't
106 afford a lawyer one will be appointed for you before any questioning if you
107 wish. If you decide to answer questions without a lawyer present you can still
108 have the right to stop answering at any time and also to have, ah, - and also
109 have the right to stop answering at any time until you talk to a lawyer.
110
111 A: Okay.
112
113 Q: Um, so do you understand each of those rights?
114
115 A: Yes.
116
117 Q: And realizing that you have those rights are you now willing to waive these
118 rights and to answer questions or make a statement about what happened this
119 evening? Can you say - like are you willing to talk with me...
120
121 A: Yeah.
122
123 Q: ...or answer questions about what happened? Yes? Okay. Then just one more
124 signature here and the date again, sorry. Okay. I'll sign it here. So I guess -
125 Let's talk a little bit about what - what happened this evening. Um, now where
126 - I just first met you over on Jefferson Street, 915, that's your address,
127 correct? Let's kinda go through the day today and just tell - tell me what your
128 day was like. Maybe start right in the morning when you - when you woke up
129 and what went on today.
130
131 A: Well when I woke up I was, I don't know, kinda feeling depressed.
132
133 Q: Okay. Feeling depressed.
134
135 A: Yeah and then I went to school and then I been - I like had like an attitude so I

136 kept to - and I didn't really talk to anybody today.
137

138 Q: Okay.
139

140 A: And then my girlfriend she came up to me and asked me, "Want to go the
141 dance?" So I asked her and then she said the time and the time was like seven
142 or six, one of those. And then I was - and then my - a friend who came and he
143 was like, "You want to do (MORP)?" And I was like, "I do not know you."
144 He was like, "I don't know. My girlfriend wants to go."
145

146 Q: Is that a school dance?
147

148 A: Yeah.
149

150 Q: From (MORP).
151

152 A: Yeah. It's like...
153

154 Q: Yeah I think I heard about it.
155

156 A: Yeah for...
157

158 Q: So when you were talking to your girlfriend was that at school or were you...
159

160 A: Yeah.
161

162 Q: Okay so when you had gotten to school. Okay. So what's your girlfriend's
163 name?
164

165 A: Um, (Lucy Jones).
166

167 Q: (Lucy), okay. So (Lucy)'s sayin', "Hey do you want to (MORP) tonight?"
168

169 A: Yeah she was - well she had asked me for a week and then...
170

171 Q: Okay.
172

173 A: ...I kinda didn't really want to go 'cause I had been (unintelligible). Then my
174 friend said that he wanted to go 'cause his girlfriend's with him so, ah, might
175 as well.
176

177 Q: Okay. Who's your friend?
178

179 A: Ah, (Troy).
180

181 Q: Okay.
182
183 A: He's my nephew too.
184
185 Q: Oh okay.
186
187 A: He's the one that was bein' shot at.
188
189 Q: Okay. So your friend (Troy) wanted to go to (MORP).
190
191 A: Yeah.
192
193 Q: Okay. Got it.
194
195 A: And then after that the day went on and then, I don't know I kinda had like a
196 crappy feeling like I was really pissed and then I found a way to like not make
197 me mad anymore.

199 Q: Okay.
200
201 A: And then after that, like, my friend and (Joe) came to my crib because they
202 said that they wanted...
203
204 Q: Now they came to your what? Your...
205
206 A: Yeah, my crib - went to the house.
207
208 Q: Okay. Your house. Okay.
209
210 A: And they said they were gonna go dancin' so we were staying upstairs...
211
212 Q: So now school's over?
213
214 A: Yeah, school's over.
215
216 Q: And you're back at your house. So, um, what time is this roughly?
217
218 A: Like three - 3:40. Yeah it's about 3:40.
219
220 Q: Okay. So 3:40 (Troy)'s there. You're there.
221
222 A: Yeah. (Troy)'s there. I'm there. Ah, (Joe). We call him (Joe).
223
224 Q: Okay. What's - what's (Joe)'s name?
225

226 A: Like (Joseph Kuy) but we call him (Joe) for short. Um, K...
227
228 Q: K-U-Y?
229
230 A: Yeah, K-U-Y.
231
232 Q: Okay. And who else? You, (Troy), (Joe)...
233
234 A: That's it.
235
236 Q: ...and that's it. So you were there hangin' out at about 3:40-ish?
237
238 A: Yeah. We got to my place at 3:40-ish.
239
240 Q: Okay. And then what?
241
242 A: And we're sitting there and sitting there and then we're talking and then
243 (Troy) had problems 'cause - well me and (Troy) both did because he wanted
244 to know what was wrong me.
245
246 Q: Okay.
247
248 A: And then I wanted to know what was wrong with him 'cause he was upset so
249 we walk outside then we're sitting on the porch talking about like how he felt
250 and how I felt and then how we explained our feelings to each other.
251
252 Q: Sure.
253
254 A: And then (Joe) was upstairs usin' the restroom.
255
256 Q: Okay.
257
258 A: And then after that we saw the car. The car came and the car stopped at the
259 corner and they got out. And they're like, "What's up?" And like - we got up.
260
261 Q: So who - how many people were - got out of the car?
262
263 A: Four or five of them. And then...
264
265 Q: Were they guys, girls?
266
267 A: Yeah, they were - they were guys except for the driver. It was a girl.
268
269 Q: Okay. Um, white guys, black guys, Asian guys?
270

271 A: Black. They're like half - they're like mixed black, white, and black and
272 Mexican.

274 Q: Okay. But the female...

276 A: Was total black.
277

278 Q: Okay. And that was the driver?

280 A: Yeah.

282 Q: Okay. So this car pulls up...

284 A: Mm-hm.

286 Q: ...all right. And they're - they're like - and you're out on the porch with
287 (Troy)?

289 A: Yeah. We're talking and then they come out and they're like, "What's up?"
290 You know, like, "What?" And then they were like - we got up and we're like,
291 "What the hell?" And then...

293 Q: What do you mean - what do you mean they got up?

295 A: Like - no we got up.

297 Q: Oh, you got up...

299 A: Yeah.

301 Q: ...off - like from where you sitting...

303 A: Yeah.

305 Q: ...on the porch?

307 A: Yeah. We're like, "What the hell?" And then they pull out a gun and then they
308 like - like the guy who pulled out a gun, his friends or his homeboys, whatever
309 they're called...

311 Q: Okay.

313 A: They all ran to the car and we're like, "You're gonna shoot us, huh?" And
314 we're like, "I don't know." And then we all like ran after him 'cause - yeah, I
315 don't know why we did that and then he started shooting. And then it sounded

316 like a real gun and then like the - you know like when you shoot a gun...

320 A: You have like the smoke and the chamber goes back and forth...

322 Q: Okay.

324 A: It looked like that so - and then I ran inside and then I grabbed a knife and I
325 ran back outside.

329 A: And then he was tryin' to shoot it at me so I - and then my nephew, (Troy)...

331 Q: Mm-hm.

333 A: ...my friend went over there and tackled him already and then he was beatin'
334 like on (Troy). So - and he was like - I don't know what he did with the gun,
335 but I was like really ticked off 'cause I didn't want my nephew to be shot at.

337 Q: Mm-hm.

339 A: So I didn't think and I just went over there and stabbed him in the back twice.
340 And then after that I ran back inside and then just put it away.

342 Q: Okay.

344 A: And they took off. And then the girl came out and then that's when we saw
345 the girl that was the driver. And then she ran back inside and they took him to
346 the hospital I guess.
347
348 A: They came to the house 'cause they saw my sign.
349
350 Q: Okay.
351
352 A: And, yeah.
353
354 Q: So when was the last time that you actually had conversations with these
355 guys?
356
357 A: Last year.
358
359 Q: Okay. Have you had any contact with them between last year and tonight?
360

361 A: Not really.
362
363 Q: No? What do you mean not really like?
364
365 A: Like some of them they message me. I was like I'm not gonna do that.
366
367 Q: Okay. M - like message you like text message or what?
368
369 A: Like Facebook messages.
370
371 Q: Oh Facebook messages.
372
373 A: I was like whatever. I don't care.
374
375 Q: Okay.
376
377 A: And then after that...
378
379 Q: So like what - you just ignored the messages?
380
381 A: Yeah.
382
383 Q: You didn't respond to them at all?
384
385 A: Oh I responded to one but I was like whatever at some point.

387 Q: Okay.
388
389 A: 'Cause he was like...
390
391 Q: When was that?
392
393 A: Ah, that was like when we got home 'cause I was reading it and then...

395 Q: When you got home, like today when you got home?
396
397 A: Yeah like today when I got home.
398
399 Q: Oh okay. So you had a message from him today?
400
401 A: Yeah.
402
403 Q: And you responded?
404
405 A: Yeah.

407 Q: Okay.

409 A: And they were like - 'cause they were talkin' about a rumble and I was like,
410 "You guys are rumblin' with my nephew, my baby nephew?" And then
411 they're like, "Yeah so what's up. Show up." And I was like, "What the hell?"
412
413 Q: Okay.

415 A: And then they were all message me. They're like - they're like sayin' all this
416 crap and crap and I was startin' to get pissed.
417
418 Q: Sure.

420 A: I was like whatever. There's no point in answering.
421
422 Q: Just before we go any further, just so we don't have to keep saying those guys
423 or this person...
424
425 A: Yeah.
426
427 Q: ...or that, or whatever, like do you know the names of these individuals?
428
429 A: I only know like two.
430
431 Q: Okay.
432
433 A: There's (Isaiah Powell), the one that I stabbed. And then...
434
435 Q: So...
436
437 A: Okay. And there's (Anthony). I don't know his last name, but yeah.
438
439 Q: (Isaiah)'s the one that had the gun?
440
441 A: Yep.
442
443 Q: And - and - and he fired the gun?
444
445 A: Mm-hm.
446
447 Q: And did you get hit at all...
448
449 A: No.
450

451 Q: ...with the gun? Did anybody get shot?
452
453 A: I don't think so. I don't know.
454
455 Q: Are there gonna be - like presumably bullet holes in your house or I mean
456 where was he...
457
458 A: No. He wasn't...
459
460 Q: ...pointing the gun at?
461
462 A: ...he wasn't shooting at the, um, the - the house because while my nephew was
463 already running towards him...
464
465 Q: Okay.
466
467 A: 'Cause when he pulled out the gun my nephew was like, "Oh hell no." And
468 then he was like running and then he was gonna attack him. He pulled out the
469 gun finally and he shot it. Like it was bouncing back so it looked like a real
470 gun to me.
471
472 Q: Mm-hm.
473
474 A: So I was like, no I'm not gonna let my nephew get - get shot so I ran inside
475 and I grabbed a knife and then I came outside. I chased after him...
476
477 Q: Okay.
478
479 A: ...and then that's when I stabbed him in the back twice.

481 Q: So what kind of gun was it. You said it wasn't a real - you said it looked like a
482 real gun...

513 A: And then like the way it sounded like, it sounded like a real gun.

560 looks like a real gun and the way it moves looks like a real gun...
561
562 Q: Okay.
563
564 A: ...and we're like, yeah I'm gonna go - I was like I'm gonna go inside...
565
566 Q: Sure.
567
568 A: ...and I was gonna go grab a knife. I was scared though. So...
569
570 Q: So at the point when you ran inside to get a knife you were thinking this was a
571 real gun or what were you thinking?
572
573 A: Yeah, I thought it was a real gun 'cause I didn't want my nephew to be shot.
574
575 Q: Okay.
576
577 A: So I ran inside.
578
579 Q: Okay.
580
581 A: And I was protecting my nephew, but, yeah.
582
583 Q: So when you ran inside to get the knife (Troy) was still outside with this guy
584 that - with the gun, I mean, that you thought was real?
585

586 A: Yeah. 'Cause I thought that he was gonna come inside with me and then he
587 didn't come inside. And I told him to come inside but he - I guess he ran after
588 him.
589

590 Q: Okay. So what were (Troy) and him doing when you ran inside, do you know?
591

592 A: I think (Troy) was already running towards him and when I got outside (Troy)
593 was like across the street...
594

595 Q: How far away were they?
596

597 A: Okay. So like here's the car and here's my house.
598

599 Q: Okay.
600

601 A: And then he was like right...
602

603 Q: Tell you what I'm gonna do for you. If I give you a piece of paper can you
604 maybe just draw like a little kind of a diagram? Just - I mean - I know it's not
605 art class, but just do the best that you can.
606

607 A: Right - yeah.
608

609 Q: Okay. So there's your house?
610

611 A: Mm-hm.
612

613 Q: Okay.
614

615 A: And then - and then like - so there's the street...
616

617 Q: Mm-hm.
618

619 A: (Unintelligible).
620

621 Q: Yep. So that's where I would have been parked, right?
622

623 A: Yeah.
624

625 Q: Okay.
626

627 A: This is where you would've been parked. And then like they were parked like
628 right here.
629

630 Q: Okay.

631
632 A: And then - so like my nephew he was sitting right here and then he came out
633 and he was like sitting right here. Then all the guys came out of the car and
634 then we - we looked...
635
636 Q: And who was here (Troy)?
637
638 A: Yeah. (Troy) and me.
639
640 Q: Can you write (Troy) right next to that just so I - okay. And who was - who
641 was here?
642
643 A: (Isaiah).
644
645 Q: Okay. Got it. Okay. Yeah, I'm not sure I got it either. Just whatever.
646
647 A: But, I mean, here's a car.
648
649 Q: Okay. So that's their vehicle that they...
650
651 A: Mm-hm.
652
653 Q: Which w - and was it facing this way or this way?
654
655 A: Yeah, the front part where they...
656
657 Q: Got it...
658
659 A: So - and then so like he pulled out a gun and then - then lift up his shirt. His
660 boys ran like all the way back into the car.
661
662 Q: Okay.
663
664 A: And then (Troy) - when he was about to shoot it a (Troy), (Troy) already ran.
665 He ran this ran this way and then he came over here. I was right inside - ran
666 inside to go grab a knife real quick. I came out and (Troy) was like comin'
667 through...
668
669 Q: And you went inside - I'm sorry to interrupt you...
670
671 A: No...
672
673 Q: But you went inside at this point because why?
674
675 A: Because he was shooting.

676
677 Q: Okay but at that point you said he was just lifting his shirt so...
678
679 A: No. I - 'cause like - 'cause like he was lifting his shirt and he pulled it out and
680 his boys came. Then his boys ran inside and then (Troy) was like, "Oh no,"
681 and then...
682
683 Q: Had he fired it already?
684
685 A: No he fired it when (Troy) was like running towards him.
686
687 Q: Okay. And that's when you...
688
689 A: Yeah that's when I ran inside...
690
691 Q: Okay.
692
693 A: ...and I got the knife and I came out.
694
695 Q: Okay.
696
697 A: And then...
698
699 Q: So when you came out where were all the - where were (Troy) and (Isaiah)?
700
701 A: (Troy) was like - okay so like (Troy) was like right about here.
702
703 Q: Okay.
704
705 A: And (Isaiah) was like right here.
706
707 Q: Okay.
708
709 A: And he was still - I don't know if he was still shooting or not. And then I
710 guess they were taggin' each other and then like they ended up over here. And
711 that's when I came in - oh probably I came in through the back right here.
712
713 Q: Okay.
714
715 A: In there so I stabbed him.
716
717 Q: Okay. So was t - were they on the ground at the time?
718
719 A: Yeah, they were - (Troy) was like on the bottom and then (Isaiah) was on top
720 punching him.

721
722 Q: Okay.
723
724 A: And then I thought he was gonna shoot him from right there too so I was, like,
725 just grabbed a knife and so boom - boom and I pulled it out and I just ran.
726
727 Q: Okay.
728
729 A: I didn't really run. I just sat there and I was like oh and he was like I can't
730 believe...
731
732 Q: So you ran or you didn't run?
733
734 A: No, I didn't run but...
735
736 Q: Okay.
737
738 A: And then like I just stood there and I was like, "Oh crap." And then he was
739 like, "I can't breathe." And they was like, "Take him to the hospital." And
740 then the female came out...
741
742 Q: Who - who said take him to the hospital?
743
744 A: His boys and the female came out. Saw a female there. That's when me and
745 (Troy) got back inside.
746
747 Q: Okay.
748
749 A: Yeah. And then after that they took off when she got in the car with him.
750
751 Q: Okay.
752
753 A: And then I guess (unintelligible) street.
754
755 Q: Was (Troy) injured at all?
756
757 A: He had a few bruises on his head (unintelligible).
758
759 Q: So when he messaged you earlier...
760
761 A: Mm-hm.
762
763 Q: The one that you said you maybe responded to, like, what it was - what did he
764 say?
765

766 A: Well he was like asking about all this crap and I was like, "What?" And was
767 like, "So are you banging stuff?" And I was like, "Yeah, I guess I do." And
768 they're like oh - they were saying all this crap like killers and I was like, "You
769 guys aren't really killers." And then I don't know after that we stopped talking
770 and then we came out - and then we went outside. That's when me and (Troy)
771 went outside.
772

773 Q: Okay. So what do you mean they - he said a bunch of crap and said do you
774 bang. Like what is - what do you mean?
775

776 A: He was like, "Are you like gangsters in it?"
777

778 Q: Okay.
779

780 A: And then - and then I told him yeah and he was like, "What's your set?" And I
781 was like, "OTB."
782

783 Q: Okay.
784

785 A: He was like, "OTBK." And I was like you're gonna say that over the screen.
786

787 Q: Uh-huh. Okay.
788

789 A: And then I just stopped messaging him. And then I was talkin' to my nephew
790 'cause they were gonna jump him...
791

792 Q: Mm-hm.
793

794 A: And I was like, "So what's happening. I heard that you're gonna get jumped."
795 He was like, "Yeah." I was like, "Well, I don't know how - how I'm gonna
796 help. I don't have a ride." And they - they said that the fight was gonna be in
797 Marathon. I was like that's (scetchy) so there ain't no point in going - only me
798 and my nephew to go so my nephew stayed and he was sit - he stayed home
799 babysittin' so.
800

801 Q: Okay.
802

803 A: And that's when they were like driving around to go pick up guys, said they
804 were gonna do a rumble.
805

806 Q: Okay.
807

808 A: And then I guess that's when they came up from here. And saw me and (Troy)
809 was like - and then they stopped the car.
810

811 Q: Okay. All right. Um, do you maybe just want write your name on here
812 showin' that like you're - you're the one that drew that picture. You want
813 some more water? Can I fill that up for you?
814

815 A: Yeah.

816

817 Q: Okay.

818

819 A: Thank you.

820

821 Q: Yeah, you bet. Just hang tight a second. I'll be right back.

822

823 A: Okay.

824

825 Q: Here you go. I'll be right with you okay? Sorry. Is - is this your phone? Okay.
826 Dylan, what's the code for the phone. Is there like a security code or anything
827 or...
828

829 A: Yeah. Ah, 2569.

830

831 Q: 2569.

832

833 A: Yeah.

834

835 Q: All I'm gonna do right now is it looks like your battery's just about dead. I'm
836 gonna, um, I'm just gonna put this on the airplane mode (unintelligible) just
837 take it off. All right. So just so I'm clear up - up to this point here, um, you
838 woke up this morning. Weren't really feelin' that great. Just kind of feeling
839 crappy. And correct me if I'm wrong on any of this. I don't want to put any
840 words or anything in your mouth okay. Um, you - you did attend school. Um,
841 talked with (Lucy) a little bit about goin' to (MORP). She had been kind of
842 asking you throughout the week about going. Um, ah, (Troy), who's your
843 friend and also your nephew also wanted to - to go to (MORP) or was talkin'
844 about it. Now how old is (Troy)?
845

846 A: (Troy) is my age.

847

848 Q: Okay fif - 15?

849

850 A: Yeah.

851

852 Q: Okay. Same grade freshman?

853

854 A: Uh-huh.

855

856 Q: All right.
857
858 A: I think he's still 14 though. I don't think he's 15.
859
860 Q: But he's a freshman?
861
862 A: Yeah he's a freshman.
863
864 Q: Okay. You indicated that you just kinda had a crappy feeling today and that
865 you were feeling pissed.
866
867 A: Mmm.
868
869 Q: Ah, you - you had gone back to your house after school and you - you
870 indicated at one point that you found a way not to be upset. What does that
871 mean?
872
873 A: Like, I found, like, kinda like a cure, you know.
874
875 Q: Okay.
876
877 A: Like, you know how like when people get mad...
878
879 Q: Mm-hm.
880
881 A: ...and they're like they try to do something that makes them not mad anymore
882 that's what I did.
883
884 Q: Okay. And what was that? What helped you not to be upset anymore?
885
886 A: Ah, talkin' with (Lucy). I haven't really talked to her all day. Then I told her
887 how I felt. And then she was, like, there to, like, comfort me about it so.
888
889 Q: Okay. You told her just about feeling depressed today?
890
891 A: Yeah.
892
893 Q: What was it that was making you feel depressed when you woke up? Do you
894 know?
895
896 A: I'm not sure. I just woke up pretty sad.
897
898 Q: Does that happen often? Do you feel that way often?
899
900 A: Yeah.

901
902 Q: Now do you take any medications or anything at all?
903
904 A: No.
905
906 Q: All right. Um, so at about 3:40 you and (Joe), who's (Joseph Kuy), and (Troy)
907 were back at your place?
908
909 A: Yep.
910
911 Q: At your house on Jefferson Street?
912
913 A: Uh-huh.
914
915 Q: Um, you became aware that (Troy) was also upset or feelin' upset today?
916
917 A: Yeah.
918
919 Q: And you and him were sitting out on the front porch kinda talking about that.
920 Did he tell you what he was upset about?
921
922 A: Well he was like stressed about his girlfriend 'cause he - I seen 'em fight a lot,
923 like argue and argue and argue and stuff so...
924
925 Q: Okay.
926
927 A: Yeah and then he was talkin' with me about that and told him about how I felt
928 and then - yeah.
929
930 Q: All right. So you guys were talking out - out on the porch and that's when you
931 saw a car pull up.
932
933 A: Mm-hm.
934
935 Q: Now what did that car look like?
936
937 A: It wasn't - well it was kinda - (unintelligible). It was like...
938
939 Q: Like an SUV.
940
941 A: Yeah.
942
943 Q: Like a truck kinda thing?
944
945 A: Yeah.

946
947 Q: Okay.
948
949 A: And then it was kinda whitish, kinda grayish. It kinda looked like silver tone. I
950 don't know.
951
952 Q: All right. And you said four or five males exited that car or...
953
954 A: Mm-hm.
955
956 Q: Okay. They all got out?
957
958 A: Yep.
959
960 Q: And, you know, they were kinda like, "What's up. What's up." Just this kinda
961 deal. Ah, you guys responded with, you know, kinda questionin' 'em like,
962 "What? Like, "What's goin' on?" Or something?
963
964 A: Yeah. And then we found it that they were (unintelligible).
965
966 Q: Okay. Did they identify themselves that you knew it was them. I mean,
967 'cause...
968
969 A: Yeah. They didn't wear anything. They just came out of the car.
970
971 Q: Okay was it dark at this time?
972
973 A: No, it was pretty light outside.
974
975 Q: Okay. So it was light outside and they - they got of the vehicle.
976
977 A: Mm-hm.
978
979 Q: And did you rec - I mean right away did you recognize them?
980
981 A: Yeah.
982
983 Q: Like you could see, like, "Hey, I know that that's so and so?"
984
985 A: Yeah I know 'em.
986
987 Q: Okay.
988
989 A: I can tell from his afro.
990

991 Q: Okay.
992
993 A: And (unintelligible) his height and all (unintelligible).
994
995 Q: Oh what was he wearing? What was (Isaiah) wearing?
996
997 A: It was like a black hat, dark jeans, you know, kinda like darkish but not that
998 dark, like a light, kinda like light green.
999
1000 Q: Okay.
1001
1002 A: Yeah.
1003
1004 Q: Okay. So you - I mean you knew him?
1005
1006 A: Yeah, I know him.
1007
1008 Q: And the other kids that were with him, did you recognize them or know them
1009 at all, know any of their names, anything like that?
1010
1011 A: Only know (Anthony).
1012
1013 Q: Okay. Do you know (Anthony)'s last name?
1014
1015 A: No.
1016
1017 Q: Okay. Do you know any of the other kids?
1018
1019 A: Um, one of them looked like (Jesus) then the other one was (Clarence) I think.
1020
1021 Q: All right. So you're - you're kinda - they're calling you guys out like, "What's
1022 up? What's up?" And you're like, "What?" You know, "What's goin' on?"
1023 (Isaiah) is lifting his shirt. Now what side - would it have been his right side
1024 or his left side, do you recall?
1025
1026 A: Left side. So it would be on his left side.
1027
1028 Q: His left side.
1029
1030 A: Yeah.
1031
1032 Q: He lifted his shirt like with his - do you recall which hand he lifted his shirt
1033 with? Was he liftin' with his left...
1034
1035 A: I don't remember.

1036
1037 Q: Okay.
1038
1039 A: All I remember is that he lifted up his shirt. I wasn't really payin' attention to
1040 his hands.
1041
1042 Q: Okay.
1043
1044 A: I remember he lifted up his shirt and I saw the gun stickin' right there. He
1045 pulled it out.
1046
1047 Q: Okay.
1048
1049 A: And then his friend came in - his friends ran back to the car.
1050
1051 Q: Okay. So he lifted his shirt and you saw the gun.
1052
1053 A: Mm-hm.
1054
1055 Q: And the friends ran back to the car.
1056
1057 A: Yep.
1058
1059 Q: Did he say anything at that time? He didn't say anything?
1060
1061 A: Uh-uh.
1062
1063 Q: Did you say anything at that time?
1064
1065 A: No. I didn't say anything. I was just like, "Oh, shit."
1066
1067 Q: Okay. Did (Troy) say anything?
1068
1069 A: Uh-uh.
1070
1071 Q: Okay.
1072
1073 A: And then after that (Troy) was like, "Oh shit." And then he pulled out the gun
1074 and then lookin' to aim at (Troy) and (Troy) was - (Troy) was like, "Oh, fuck
1075 this." So he ran.
1076
1077 Q: Okay and that was - when we get back to here...
1078
1079 A: Yeah.
1080

1081 Q: ...that's where (Troy) started running this way.
1082

1083 A: And then I ran back inside.
1084

1085 Q: Now were you out there long enough to see (Troy) cut over, I mean 'cause
1086 you...
1087

1088 A: Yeah. I saw him cut right here and then I'm pretty sure he went straight right
1089 over here.
1090

1091 Q: Okay.
1092

1093 A: 'Cause that...
1094

1095 Q: So you didn't - you didn't actually see him make this turn right here?
1096

1097 A: Yeah. I remember just seein' him run straight. I ran inside.
1098

1099 Q: Okay.
1100

1101 A: And then when I got outside he was right there so I booked it as hard as I - as
1102 fast I could.
1103

1104 Q: Okay. 'Cause when you came back out now they're over here?
1105

1106 A: Yeah they were over there and then that's when they grappling and - 'cause
1107 when (Isaiah) was on top of (Troy) and (Isaiah) was like punching him and I
1108 was like...
1109

1110 Q: How was (Troy) on the ground? I mean was he like on his hands and knees?
1111 Was he on his back? Was he on his side?
1112

1113 A: On his back like this and then...
1114

1115 Q: He was on his back?
1116

1117 A: Yeah (Isaiah) was like - like sitting on him just whamming at him so then I
1118 got a chance to stab in the back so I did.
1119

1120 Q: Okay. Was (Isaiah) standing over him? So if - if (Troy) - if (Troy)'s on the
1121 ground and he's kinda up like this, you know, kinda maybe tryin' to protect
1122 himself or...
1123

1124 A: Yeah he was doin' that pretty well.
1125

1126 Q: Okay on his back.
1127
1128 A: And then...
1129
1130 Q: Was (Isaiah) standing? Was he kneeling? I mean how...
1131
1132 A: He was just like kneeling on like one then he was like kinda like his knee was
1133 up.
1134
1135 Q: Okay.
1136
1137 A: So he was kinda like, yeah, I don't know what you want to call that.
1138
1139 Q: Okay.
1140
1141 A: And he was like whamming on (Troy) and I just got up behind him and just
1142 one, two and I pulled it out.
1143
1144 Q: Okay.
1145
1146 A: Yeah.
1147
1148 Q: Where - where on (Isaiah) did you stab him?
1149
1150 A: I am not sure. I was not thinking. It goes black and...
1151
1152 Q: Sure.
1153
1154 A: ...like you're...
1155
1156 Man: Picture right here.
1157
1158 Q: Okay. How far do you think the knife went in?
1159
1160 A: I am not sure. I closed my eyes.
1161
1162 Q: Sure.
1163
1164 A: Lookin' at that and I was like, "Oh, crap."
1165
1166 Q: Okay. How big of a knife was it?
1167
1168 A: That long.
1169
1170 Q: Okay. Like a - was it a kitchen knife or...

1171
1172 A: It was a homemade knife.
1173
1174 Q: A homemade knife?
1175
1176 A: Yeah like you Hmong - Hmong knives.
1177
1178 Q: Like a Hmong knife?
1179
1180 A: Yeah a Hmong knife.
1181
1182 Q: Okay. And so was it your knife or was it just a knife in the house?
1183
1184 A: A knife in the house that we use for cooking.
1185
1186 Q: For cooking. Okay. How many times do you think you saw (Isaiah) hit, ah,
1187 (Troy)?
1188
1189 A: Like - I don't have a - I remember seein with one, but he was like - I wasn't
1190 really paying attention 'cause I was - like the first time when he hit him I was
1191 like already recognize him just getting ready to - then he went one, two, three
1192 and (Troy) was like blocking. It starts with that and after that when (Troy) got
1193 up he had like - like three marks right here on his head.
1194
1195 Q: Where was the gun at that point when he was...
1196
1197 A: I am not sure what happened to it.
1198
1199 Q: Do you recall seeing it anywhere in like - do you recall...
1200
1201 A: I remember...
1202
1203 Q: ...seeing it...
1204
1205 A: I remember seeing it in his hand when he was whamming on (Troy) but I
1206 don't know what happened after that.
1207
1208 Q: Okay. So you recall seeing it in (Isaiah)'s hand while he was hitting (Troy)?
1209
1210 A: Yeah.
1211
1212 Q: Do you remember which hand it was in?
1213
1214 A: I think it - I think it was in his right hand.
1215

1216 Q: In his right hand.
1217
1218 A: Yeah.
1219
1220 Q: Was he swinging with his right hand with the gun in the hand or was he
1221 swinging with his left hand?
1222
1223 A: He was swinging with his left.
1224
1225 Q: Okay.
1226
1227 A: And I got...
1228
1229 Q: And holding the gun in the right hand?
1230
1231 A: Yeah. And I thought that it was a real gun 'cause it didn't have that orange tip
1232 on it.
1233
1234 Q: Okay. Describe the gun a little bit more for me. I know it was missing - or
1235 didn't have an orange tip.
1236
1237 A: And then like - okay so like...
1238
1239 Q: What color was it?
1240
1241 A: Um, is it okay if I draw on here?
1242
1243 Q: Yeah.
1244
1245 A: (Unintelligible) like, looked kinda like that.
1246
1247 Q: Okay.
1248
1249 A: And then there's like tip - it didn't have a (unintelligible) on it. And then like
1250 the back part kinda looked silver and then like - yeah kinda like this. Like,
1251 that's - that's from the image that I saw it.
1252
1253 Q: Sure.
1254
1255 A: It looked - do you how like where the - what you call it again - you know
1256 where like the bullets fly out?
1257
1258 Q: The chamber?
1259
1260 A: Yeah the chamber.

1261
1262 Q: Or the barrel?
1263
1264 A: Yeah the barrel was a silver.
1265
1266 Q: Okay.
1267
1268 A: And then when he shot it, it went back and you could see smoke here.
1269 Thought that was a real gun. It didn't have a orange tip to it.
1270
1271 Q: So was the whole gun silver or it another color also?
1272
1273 A: No it was black...
1274
1275 Q: Okay.
1276
1277 A: ...on like the chamber.
1278
1279 Q: Black and silver.
1280
1281 A: Yeah.
1282
1283 Q: Got it. All right. So - okay so we're on the same page up to that point. He was
1284 stabbed twice. You stabbed him twice with this, I don't know, what are you
1285 thinking?
1286
1287 A: Yeah.
1288
1289 Q: That (unintelligible). Maybe about a foot, about 12 inches? Okay. Um, and
1290 then what happened? Let's - I know you told me this already. I just want to
1291 make sure that I'm understanding correctly.
1292
1293 A: All right.
1294
1295 Q: Um, after he was stabbed twice. After you stabbed him.
1296
1297 A: Oh I pulled out the knife and I just stood there and I was like, "Oh, f-" you
1298 know...
1299
1300 Q: Sure.
1301
1302 A: And then he got up and he was like, "I can't breathe." And then they're like -
1303 the guys came out of the car and they picked him up. They're like, "Let's go
1304 to the hospital." The girl came out and that was like - I was standin'
1305 backwards and I saw the girl come out. And the girl was standing right there

1306 when I was standin' backwards and then (Troy) got up and (Troy) is like,
1307 "This dude's - lets go." And I was like, ah, "Yes." And then he looked at me.
1308 They took off.
1309
1310 Q: Okay. Where did you go after that?
1311
1312 A: Ah, back in the kitchen to put it away. I didn't see no blood on it but I don't
1313 know if there was blood on there or not.
1314
1315 Q: Okay.
1316
1317 A: 'Cause I just took a quick glance at that and I just put it in so...
1318
1319 Q: So you - excuse me - you put the knife back in the house in the kitchen?
1320
1321 A: Yeah.
1322
1323 Q: Like put it away or did you - where did you set it?
1324
1325 A: I put it away in the drawer that the knives are in.
1326
1327 Q: And did you see the vehicle leave?
1328
1329 A: No 'cause we...
1330
1331 Q: You were...
1332
1333 A: ...we looked back outside and the vehicle was gone.
1334
1335 Q: Okay.
1336
1337 A: I guess it took off.
1338
1339 Q: So you had already gone inside while they were presumably putting (Isaiah)
1340 into the vehicle?
1341
1342 A: Yeah and then they took off I'm pretty sure 'cause when we looked back
1343 outside where they were (unintelligible).
1344
1345 Q: So (Isaiah) said that he couldn't breathe?
1346
1347 A: Yeah. And they're all like, "Oh take him to the hospital. Take him to the
1348 hospital."
1349
1350 Q: Were you surprised to see his vehicle come down your street when you and

1351 (Troy) were sitting out on the porch talking?
1352
1353 A: No 'cause like there would always be cars that does that. They would like
1354 come down like fast but then it goes slower 'cause...
1355
1356 Q: Sure.
1357
1358 A: There's people who always go to like this house that's across the street from
1359 us. And then it would always go there so I'm used to it. And then when I saw
1360 it stop - it like basically stopped where you can't really park.
1361
1362 Q: Mm-hm.
1363
1364 A: And then we look and we're like, "What the hell?" And then they got out of
1365 the car. We're like, "Oh." Then they got out and I saw 'em. That's when...
1366
1367 Q: So were - were you surprised to see that it was (Isaiah)?
1368
1369 A: I thought it was gonna be someone else.
1370
1371 Q: Okay.
1372
1373 A: I thought it was gonna be someone that we knew.
1374
1375 Q: So you weren't expecting (Isaiah)?
1376
1377 A: Uh-uh. Then (Isaiah) came out and then four or three other came out so I like,
1378 you know...
1379
1380 Q: Yeah. So he had messaged you earlier on Facebook, right?
1381
1382 A: Mm-hm.
1383
1384 Q: Did he indicate he was gonna come to your house? Don't know? Did you
1385 invite him to come over to your house at all?
1386
1387 A: I never did that. Not him. If know - if he ever comes over pretty sure that
1388 that's a bad idea 'cause we're gonna end up fighting each other.
1389
1390 Q: Okay.
1391
1392 A: It's like, yeah, once was our (chilla G), gangster disciples.
1393
1394 Q: Uh-huh.
1395

1396 A: And then few of them are kinda chill with us 'cause we're chill with like a few
1397 of 'em. They're like really cool.
1398

1399 Q: Okay.
1400

1401 Q: Now you had said somethin' a little bit ago that just made me wonder about
1402 any current gang activity, um, in his message to you said something about
1403 some - some type of gang activity?
1404

1405 A: Yeah he was like, "You bang?" I was like, "Yeah." (Cory) was like OTB. And
1406 he's like, "OTBK." I was like, "You guys aren't killers in here. Ain't got no
1407 balls to do anything." And then I stopped talkin' to him when he messaged me
1408 back.
1409

1410 Q: Okay. So you're involved in a gang called OTB?
1411

1412 A: I was.
1413

1414 Q: You were.
1415

1416 A: Yeah. I still rep it, you know.
1417

1418 Q: Okay and what does that mean you still rep it?
1419

1420 A: Meaning like I still wear the colors of the gang. So what I did was very dumb.
1421

1422 Q: So either - I mean you're telling me you used to be in the gang but you still
1423 represent the gang?
1424

1425 A: Yeah I still represent pretty much - I don't really like...
1426

1427 Q: So does that mean you're still in the gang?
1428

1429 A: I just wear the colors.
1430

1431 Q: Okay.
1432

1433 A: I don't like to chill with them (unintelligible) so...
1434

1435 Q: Okay. And why is that?
1436

1437 A: I don't really know.
1438

1439 Q: Is (Troy) involved with OTB?
1440

1441 A: He was back in sixth grade.
1442
1443 Q: In sixth grade he was?
1444
1445 A: Yeah.
1446
1447 Q: Okay. Is (Joe) involved with OTB?
1448
1449 A: Um, really not sure. I don't think he wears red clothes so I don't think...
1450
1451 Q: But I mean you would know, right, if you were in OTB you would probably
1452 know who the other members are?
1453
1454 A: Not if they recruitin' people.
1455
1456 Q: Okay.
1457
1458 A: They always lookin' for people to recruit. That's what they tell me.
1459
1460 Q: Who's, "They?"
1461
1462 A: Ah, the old people like the OG's.
1463
1464 Q: Who are those guys?
1465
1466 A: I forgot their name but they...
1467
1468 Q: Come on.
1469
1470 A: No, I'm sayin...
1471
1472 Q: You been doin' really well. Now you're gonna tell me you forgot the name of
1473 your guys that you were in the gang with?
1474
1475 A: 'Cause I wasn't really hangin' out with them. I only hung with them like once
1476 or twice.
1477
1478 Q: Okay.
1479
1480 A: And then I didn't really catch their names because you know like, ah, gang
1481 people have gang names.
1482
1483 Q: Mm-hm. Yeah.
1484
1485 A: So I didn't really understand the names and then I wasn't really there to kick it

1486 with them. They were just talking about it and I left.
1487
1488 Q: So what was your gang name?
1489
1490 A: Mine was (Little G).
1491
1492 Q: Do you think that this incident tonight involving (Isaiah) and you was gang
1493 related?
1494
1495 A: I am not sure. I feel like it is but...
1496
1497 Q: Why - why - why do you feel like it - it is?
1498
1499 A: Kinda sense - GD - I know that GD are Crips and the OTB are Bloods.
1500
1501 Q: Okay.
1502
1503 A: And then since they always be like - always talking a lot of crap. They're like,
1504 "Rep your set," you know.
1505
1506 Q: Okay.
1507
1508 A: And I was like, "Yeah I used to rep my set," but I said it was OTB.
1509
1510 Q: Okay.
1511
1512 A: And then "O," was like, "Oh, yeah, you're true OG? OTBK." I was like,
1513 "Fuck," you know and then, yeah and that's when all that crap...
1514
1515 Q: Okay. I'll just put your phone away. Just - I'll be right back with you okay,
1516 man? You still doin' okay over there in your water and stuff?
1517
1518 A: Yeah.
1519
1520 Q: All right. Hang tight for a second.
1521
1522 A: All right.
1523
1524 Man: Sorry, I just need to grab a couple things.
1525
1526 Q: When - when (Isaiah) sent you that message earlier via Facebook...
1527
1528 A: Mm-hm.
1529
1530 Q: Um, did you respond with your phone...

1531
1532 A: Yeah.
1533
1534 Q: ...to that? Okay.
1535
1536 A: Well it wasn't really a - yeah but...
1537
1538 Q: But I mean you used your phone to get...
1539
1540 A: Yeah.
1541
1542 Q: ...access Facebook, like a Facebook app or messenger or somethin'. Um, what
1543 I'd like to do, um, is get your permission to search this phone and just get any
1544 of the information that's on the phone that might be helpful for us in
1545 understanding this case. Um, would we have your permission to do that?
1546
1547 A: (Unintelligible).
1548
1549 Q: Well, then we're probably gonna hold on to it and apply for a search warrant.
1550
1551 A: What does that mean?
1552
1553 Q: It means that we would ask permission from the court to search your phone
1554 and we would keep it in evidence until we - if - if we were granted that
1555 permission, you know, that's - I mean we would apply for it. I'm not just
1556 carvin' it stone sayin' we would get it, but I'm just...
1557
1558 A: Okay.
1559
1560 Q: So you would give your permission?
1561
1562 A: Yeah.
1563
1564 Q: You would give your consent? And I don't know if it's gonna be important to
1565 us right now at all. I just kinda want to cover all of our bases. Can I use that
1566 pen for just a second then I'll - see here. Do you have a middle initial, Dylan?
1567
1568 A: Uh, K.
1569
1570 Q: Okay. So it's D-Y-L-A-N?
1571
1572 A: Yeah.
1573
1574 Q: Dylan K. Yang, right?
1575

1576 A: Yeah.
1577
1578 Q: And what is your date of birth?
1579
1580 A: 11-29-90.
1581
1582 Q: 1990. What's your phone number?
1583
1584 A: Ah, 715.
1585
1586 Q: Okay.
1587
1588 A: 370.
1589
1590 Q: All right.
1591
1592 A: 0528.
1593
1594 Q: 0528? And you're livin' at 915 Jefferson. Could you hang - I was like wait a
1595 minute okay. All right. Okay. Is - the number you gave me is that the number
1596 for this phone?
1597
1598 A: Yeah.
1599
1600 Q: Okay. So it's And it's an Apple. What is this, is this a...
1601
1602 A: Five.
1603
1604 Q: It's a five - 5s?
1605
1606 A: No 5c.
1607
1608 Q: 5c?
1609
1610 A: Yeah.
1611
1612 Q: Okay. All right. So right here - it's kinda similar to that last one. It says I
1613 understand that I have the right to refuse to consent to the search and to refuse
1614 to sign this form. I further state that no promises, threats, force, or physical or
1615 mental coercion of any kind have been used against me to persuade me to
1616 consent to the search or to sign this form. The aforementioned property, which
1617 is this phone right here - oops can I have it back? I'm sorry.
1618
1619 A: Okay.
1620

- 1621 Q: ...is owned or rented by me or otherwise legally under my control. So this is
1622 your phone. I further give this officer, that's me, or his or her designee, which
1623 would be kinda somebody from the police department, permission to remove
1624 any contraband substances, stolen property, or other evidence of any other - of
1625 any - yeah - of any other crime. I willingly give my permission to the named
1626 officers, or his or her designee, to conduct a complete search of the
1627 aforementioned property. Um, this one doesn't really pertain to you but I'll
1628 read it anyway. I understand that any biological samples may be presented to
1629 the appropriate crime laboratory for analysis. I understand the samples may be
1630 used for this investigation and any other investigation or any legitimate law
1631 enforcement purposes. But we're talkin' about a phone. We're not really
1632 talking about biological samples. But if you agree with that that there hasn't
1633 been any threats, or force, or promises, or anything like that and that you're
1634 still willing to give your consent or your permission you could go ahead and
1635 sign there if you're in agreement with that. You're quite the artist here. A
1636 doodler, huh. Do you do that at school too during the day when the teachers
1637 are talking?
1638
- 1639 A: Yeah.
1640
- 1641 Q: That's what I do.
1642
- 1643 A: Yep.
1644
- 1645 Q: Yep date. Still the, ah, 27th and it is 9:21 pm All right let's see if we can.
1646 What was that code again?
1647
- 1648 A: Um, 2560.
1649
- 1650 Q: 2560. All right. Now, and I don't want to - I just want to really make sure that
1651 I understand, you know, what - what happened here and that I'm - oops -
1652 getting an accurate picture of the incident. So I might - I might ask the same
1653 question a couple of times. I'm not - I'm not trying to stump the chump here
1654 or anything I just really want to make sure I - I'm understanding correctly.
1655 Um, at the point where (Isaiah)'s outside the vehicle, and the other kids had -
1656 had gone back into the vehicle - this is as he's - he's lifting his shirt - you saw
1657 a gun?
1658
- 1659 A: Uh-huh. Sort of like in his pants.
1660
- 1661 Q: Okay. Tucked in his waistband or something?
1662
- 1663 A: Yeah.
1664
- 1665 Q: Okay. So he removed the gun. Did - you saw him take the gun out of his

1666 waistband?
1667
1668 A: Mm-hm.
1669
1670 Q: Did he point it in your direction?
1671
1672 A: He was pointing basically at both of us. I don't know who he was pointing at.
1673
1674 Q: Okay.
1675
1676 A: But then he was like - when (Troy) saw it so (Troy) ran and that's then when
1677 he was shooting.
1678
1679 Q: Okay.
1680
1681 A: And then it sounded like a real gun so I ran inside to grab a knife.
1682
1683 Q: Okay. So it sounded like a real gun. How many times did you hear the sound
1684 that sounded like a real gun?
1685
1686 A: Boom - boom - boom - boom - boom - boom and that's when (Troy) tackled
1687 him.
1688
1689 Q: So maybe seven?
1690
1691 A: Maybe seven.
1692
1693 Q: And (Troy) tackled him?
1694
1695 A: Yeah (Troy) tackled him.
1696
1697 Q: So you saw (Troy) tackle him?
1698
1699 A: Yeah when I got outside with the knife. That - 'cause like when he was
1700 running here I was already inside. I saw him running over here and then when
1701 he came out here I was already like at the door where - do you know like our
1702 screen is?
1703
1704 Q: Uh-huh.
1705
1706 A: You could see the car from there so I saw (Troy) and (Troy) was already over
1707 there so I opened up the screen and I - I just started running.
1708
1709 Q: Okay. So when he pulled - when he's here and he pulls this gun out of his
1710 waistband how long was it before you went inside to get the knife?

1711
1712 A: Well when I first saw the gun me and (Troy) looked at each other and I ran
1713 inside really quick.
1714
1715 Q: So had he fired the gun before you went inside to get the knife?
1716
1717 A: Yeah. And then - he fired the gun and then I was like, "Oh," and then (Troy)
1718 was already running 'cause (Troy) saw it too. And then (Troy) was runnin'
1719 this way and he was firing at - I don't know who he was firing at but then
1720 when he was firing I ran inside real quick to go grab a knife and I came out
1721 and he was...
1722
1723 Q: So how many...
1724
1725 A: ...like right here and then...
1726
1727 Q: How many times did he fire the gun before you went inside?
1728
1729 A: Like at least three times. Three or four times.
1730
1731 Q: Okay. And he was pointing it in your direction?
1732
1733 A: In our direction, me and (Troy)'s.
1734
1735 Q: Okay. So toward the house here somewhere?
1736
1737 A: Yeah.
1738
1739 Q: Like from here he was pointing it in this general direction? Okay. So then you
1740 went in the house. Did you - could you hear it firing more while you were in
1741 the house?
1742
1743 A: I heard it like once more and then I ran back outside and that's when (Troy)
1744 was like way across here.
1745
1746 Q: And so you had the gun at that time?
1747
1748 A: Huh?
1749
1750 Q: Or I'm sorry. You had the knife at that time?
1751
1752 A: Yeah.
1753
1754 Q: And - and now you saw (Troy) tackle (Isaiah)?
1755

1756 A: Yeah and then I saw the gun still in his hand so I ran over there.
1757

1758 Q: Okay 'cause when earlier, and maybe I'm just missing this, it sounded like
1759 earlier you told me you - you - you came out and had the knife and (Troy) was
1760 on the ground with (Isaiah) over him hitting him but know you're telling me
1761 that you actually saw (Troy) tackle (Isaiah)?
1762

1763 A: Yeah. I was right here - (Troy) was like here and he was about to tackle
1764 (Isaiah) when I came out.
1765

1766 Q: Okay.
1767

1768 A: So it was like - kinda like a in between where they're on top and then (Isaiah)
1769 was top and then (Troy) was like tackling immediately.
1770

1771 Q: Okay.
1772

1773 A: So...
1774

1775 Q: So (Troy) tackles (Isaiah). Do they kinda roll around? What happens?
1776

1777 A: Yeah they rolled around. (Troy) was the one who got on top first and they
1778 rolled around.
1779

1780 Q: Okay. So they rolled around and then (Troy) ended up on the bottom...
1781

1782 A: Yeah and then (Isaiah) was on the top.
1783

1784 Q: Okay. At what point did you realize that this was not a real gun?
1785

1786 A: Ah, when we came inside. (Troy) was like, "I don't think that was a real gun."
1787 I was like, "Oh shit." And then (Troy) was like, "Yeah I think it - I think it
1788 was a BB gun or something." I was like, "It sounded like a real gun and
1789 looked like one," 'cause I told him that it didn't have the orange tip. And I
1790 told him about how it shot and like the way it bounces back and that the
1791 smoke comes from it.
1792

1793 Q: Okay.
1794

1795 A: And I thought I saw shells still comin' from it too, but I'm not sure. I think it
1796 was just (unintelligible).
1797

1798 Q: So did (Troy) - So (Troy) is the one that told you when you were back inside
1799 the house after the car had left, after you had stabbed (Isaiah)...
1800

1801 A: Yeah, that it was probably...
1802
1803 Q: ...he's the one that said, "I don't think that was a real gun."
1804
1805 A: Yeah. He was like, "I think that was a BB gun." And I was like, "Oh shoot."
1806 And I was like, "You sure?" And he was like, "Yeah, 'cause the I think he
1807 was hitting us but I don't think it went through." I was like, "Oh fuck."
1808
1809 Q: Okay. Did (Troy) at any point before the stabbing, before you went in to get
1810 the knife, before you came back out, did he at any point say, "Hey that's an
1811 Airsoft," or, "That's a BB gun?"
1812
1813 A: Uh-uh. He thought that it was a real gun.
1814
1815 Q: So what do you think now about it?
1816
1817 A: That I really, really messed up really bad.
1818
1819 Q: Why do you say that?
1820
1821 A: Because I mistaken - I mistaked it as real gun 'cause if it was a real gun then I
1822 don't know what I would have done. I mean I don't know if it's - if it was a
1823 real gun and my nephew got shot I don't know how far I would take it.
1824
1825 Q: Yeah.
1826
1827 A: I would probably take it to murder or something. I don't know.
1828
1829 Q: Okay.
1830
1831 A: Because for me if it was actually my family how I would protect them is by
1832 fighting for them, you know, like fighting back.
1833
1834 Q: Sure.
1835
1836 A: 'Cause, I don't know, that's how I see it. And then my parents did. They like
1837 calling me a (unintelligible), you know, and I don't think - I wasn't thinking
1838 of that. At that time I was just really mad. I didn't want my nephew to get
1839 hurt. He was already running toward 'em so I was like why should I call the
1840 cops. Have my nephew get shot is one thing.
1841
1842 Q: Mm-hm.
1843
1844 A: Cops show up really late, you know. I was like I don't want that to happen so
1845 I just ran inside, I guess, and grabbed the knife 'cause I guess I can't control

1846 myself and then I just stabbed him so...

1847

1848 Q: So how do you know it wasn't a real gun?

1849

1850 A: Because (Troy) told me. (Troy) was like - I think (Troy) got hit and then - I

1851 think he was actually hitting (Troy) but I don't think (Troy) felt anything.

1852

1853 Q: Okay.

1854

1855 A: 'Cause then - and then after that, after we went back inside, I think - and

1856 (Troy) was like, "I think that was a BB gun." I was like, "Ah, f-" you know? I

1857 was like I guess I was mistaking it for a real gun 'cause it looked like one. It

1858 looked exactly like one 'cause I know that Airsofts they have an orange tip.

1859 That one didn't have an orange tip.

1860

1861 Q: Tell me a little bit more about OTB again.

1862

1863 A: OTB?

1864

1865 Q: How many guys do you think are involve with OTB?

1866

1867 A: I'm not sure. Most of them are quit. I know that for sure. Everybody quit it.

1868 It's an easy - an easy joining and quit. You just tell them, "I can't join."

1869 They're like, "Yeah." And refuse to...

1870

1871 Q: What do you have to do to be part of the gang?

1872

1873 A: You don't do nothing. You just kick it and then you grill, basic do anything

1874 and then if you want out you just tell them you want out and they're like, "Oh

1875 that's fine." They understand. It was like - it was first it was Oriental True

1876 Blood and then it turned to original true Blooders.

1877

1878 Q: Okay.

1879

1880 A: And when I joined it was original true Blooders. So we don't have a leader -

1881 didn't have a leader when I was in. We would basically watch each other's

1882 back. We were like - we see each other as - we're not like those top - top - top

1883 where you have a leader and you follow him. We was like you're on your own

1884 - you're your own man, you know, and they were telling me that. I was like,

1885 "Oh cool." So...

1886

1887 Q: Who's, "They?"

1888

1889 A: Like all the other OTB members that were in it back then.

1890

1891 Q: So who were those guys?
1892
1893 A: Ah, there was (Boner).
1894
1895 Q: Okay.
1896
1897 A: And then there was...
1898
1899 Q: (Sparker).
1900
1901 A: That was his name. Yeah (Boner), (Sparker), and (Big D).
1902
1903 Q: These are older kids?
1904
1905 A: Yeah. They all quit a long time ago. I see 'em around 'cause they aren't
1906 actually (unintelligible).
1907
1908 Q: Yeah.
1909
1910 A: They were like - yeah. I was talking to them. They were like, "Yeah, I'm done
1911 with that." And then they were like, "Yeah, I moved on from that." So, yeah,
1912 and they're like, "Yeah I was thinking about having a family, man."
1913
1914 Q: Yeah.
1915
1916 A: I was like, "Yeah. That's good." (Unintelligible) do that like you did.
1917 (Unintelligible).
1918
1919 Q: Yeah.
1920
1921 Q: Okay. When did you move here?
1922
1923 A: Like when I was in sixth grade.
1924
1925 Q: What about (Joseph), (Kuy), and (Troy) - what about their involvement with
1926 OTB?
1927
1928 A: Ah, (Troy) 'cause the story that (Troy) told me was he kinda wanted
1929 protection for the family.
1930
1931 Q: Uh-huh.
1932
1933 A: And they were gonna give it to him.
1934
1935 Q: Uh-huh.

1936
1937 A: So he wanted to join OTB and when his parents found out they're like, "You
1938 know you're stupid to join a gang."
1939
1940 Q: That was (Troy)?
1941
1942 A: Yeah this is (Troy). I don't know in the sixth grade (Troy) quit. Back when I
1943 first met (Troy) he was in. When I first met...
1944
1945 Q: What about - What about (Joseph)?
1946
1947 A: I met this year. I know his brother (John), (John Kuy). I'm not sure if (Joe)
1948 was an OTB or not.
1949
1950 Q: You're not sure?
1951
1952 A: I'll ask him about that.
1953
1954 Q: And (Joe) wasn't outside for any of this incident at all?
1955
1956 A: (Joe) is inside. It was just me and (Troy).
1957
1958 Q: What if I told you that both (Troy) and (Joe) have told officers within the last
1959 half an hour that they were part of OTB along with you?
1960
1961 A: Yeah. They were. I just didn't know about (Joe).
1962
1963 Q: All right.
1964
1965 A: And then...
1966
1967 Q: So here's a guy in your house, using your toilet and you don't know that he's
1968 part of the gang that you're part of?
1969
1970 A: No, 'cause I was but then...
1971
1972 Q: But you're not part of it anymore?
1973
1974 A: No.
1975
1976 Q: All right. Just want to refresh my notes here. I have - I have some photographs
1977 of some Facebook comments, okay?
1978
1979 A: Mm-hm.
1980

1981 Q: And it's - it's a Facebook message conversation. And one is from a (Little G
1982 Yang).
1983
1984 A: Yeah, that's me.
1985
1986 Q: Okay. That's you. And another is (Freddy YRS Zamora).
1987
1988 A: Okay. I don't remember names.
1989
1990 Q: (Freedy)?
1991
1992 A: Yeah that's (Isaiah).
1993
1994 Q: That's (Isaiah)?
1995
1996 A: Yep.
1997
1998 Q: Okay.
1999
2000 A: (Unintelligible) He was like, "Yeah you're already a mark. Maybe you're
2001 gonna get your ass shot and killed."
2002
2003 Q: So he says, "OTBK niggah."
2004
2005 A: Yeah.
2006
2007 Q: So what did you interpret that to mean? What does the OTBK mean to you?
2008
2009 A: Ah, OTB Killers.
2010
2011 Q: OTB Killers.
2012
2013 A: Yeah.
2014
2015 Q: And you're OTB? So did you interpret that as a - as a threat against you or a
2016 disrespect against you?
2017
2018 A: Disrespect and threat. And then he told me that I wasn't worth (unintelligible)
2019 meaning that...
2020
2021 Q: Okay.
2022
2023 A: ...I was watching for him.
2024
2025 Q: So how did you respond to this when he's making these comments to you?

2026
2027 A: I got really mad so I responded, "Oh, yeah, what the fuck?" Like, "Oh yeah
2028 you're not a true killer," and all that. "All you guys (unintelligible)."
2029
2030 Q: What does that say?
2031
2032 A: GD Killers.
2033
2034 Q: "GDK bitch."
2035
2036 A: Yeah.
2037
2038 Q: So that means GD killers. Is (Isaiah) GD?
2039
2040 A: GD - I don't know if he's GD or not.
2041
2042 Q: So were you indicating that - that - that you're a GDK, a GD Killer?
2043
2044 A: Yeah, something like that. I was really mad so I really wasn't thinking. So
2045 whenever I get mad I just type whatever.
2046
2047 Q: Okay. And then you said, "OTB gang all the way."
2048
2049 A: Uh-huh.
2050
2051 Q: So now earlier you said you're not in OTB anymore. You're just rep'ing
2052 OTB.
2053
2054 A: Yeah.
2055
2056 Q: I'm not the brightest bulb out there, but that sounds to me like someone who is
2057 a member of OTB if they're saying, "GDK OTB gang all the way." Like
2058 we're the best gang and we're gonna kill you. Is that - am I interpreting this
2059 correctly?
2060
2061 A: No.
2062
2063 Q: I'm not interpreting this correctly?
2064
2065 A: Meaning like...
2066
2067 Q: Is there a different way to interpret this?
2068
2069 A: Yeah meaning like - GD meaning like you disrespect them.
2070

2071 Q: Uh-huh.
2072

2073 A: 'Cause they - since they disrespect then you disrespect them back and you say
2074 that you're the top.
2075

2076 Q: Okay. But if you're not part of the gang, why are you saying, "OTB gang all
2077 the way?"
2078

2079 A: I don't know I just - like to say that sometimes - most - sometimes I
2080 (unintelligible).
2081

2082 Q: You just like to say that sometimes.
2083

2084 A: Yeah like whenever I'm mad I just like to say, "Oh, yeah I'm OTB,"
2085 whatever. Then like whenever I'm calm I'm just like...
2086

2087 Q: "I'm not OTB."
2088

2089 A: Yeah, I'm not really OTB.
2090

2091 Q: Do you sense I have a little bit of a problem with that?
2092

2093 A: Yeah, I know.
2094

2095 Q: Okay. Let's read a couple more.
2096

2097 A: Okay.
2098

2099 Q: Okay. So he's - he's upset. I mean I can - I can tell that.
2100

2101 Q: And he says, again, "OTBK all the way." Um, you're kind of chiding him or
2102 teasing him, you know, "You all ain't no killers." Right?
2103

2104 A: Yeah.
2105

2106 Q: I mean it's kinda what you told me before. Um, let's see here. You're telling
2107 him, "I came from Cali. What's up bitch." Okay. Um, he's really - I mean
2108 obviously this is, you know, he's really gettin' into this. That's a lot of
2109 OTBK's probably about...
2110

2111 A: Yeah that's how I got really mad.
2112

2113 Q: ...probably about 40 of 'em. Why did that upset you?
2114

2115 A: Because he was like OTB Killers and he...

2116
2117 Q: Okay. But you're not part of the OTB.
2118
2119 A: Yeah, I know. It just upset me how they say that 'cause they think I'm OTB.
2120
2121 Q: Okay.
2122
2123 A: But then like whenever I'm pissed, I'm like whatever, I'm OTB.
2124
2125 Q: Then yeah.
2126
2127 A: Whatever then.
2128
2129 Q: So it's sort of a conditional gang membership.
2130
2131 A: Yeah.
2132
2133 Q: You're member when you're upset but you're not a member when you're not
2134 upset?
2135
2136 A: Like whenever I'm upset I just - I'm just like yeah OTB whatever, you know,
2137 (unintelligible).
2138
2139 Q: And then you counter - the next comments of yours with, "GDK all day."
2140
2141 A: Yeah.
2142
2143 Q: Again.
2144
2145 A: Yeah, OTB Killers, or whatever dude. It's GDK whatever.
2146
2147 Q: Which means GD Killer?
2148
2149 A: Yeah 'cause they were just saying...
2150
2151 Q: Okay.
2152
2153 A: OTB Killers.
2154
2155 Q: You also said no weapons and no knives. What do you - what did you mean
2156 by that?
2157
2158 A: Because, like, whenever they want to rumble they're always like no weapons,
2159 no knives, like okay and then we will come 'cause like they said that they're
2160 true gangsters. I was like true gangsters carry knives, guns and all and you

2161 guys said you guys are killers. How you guys gonna be killers when you guys
2162 don't carry weapons around to beat anybody with a (stezal and chival).
2163

2164 Q: Okay. So by you saying no weapons and no knives you were I mean was this
2165 a challenge to fight...
2166

2167 A: Uh-uh.
2168

2169 Q: ...or was this pointing out that they don't carry weapons and knives?
2170

2171 A: Yeah. Pointing out that they don't carry weapons because they say that they're
2172 true gangsters.
2173

2174 Q: Got it.
2175

2176 A: And I was like, "You're not a true gangster. You guys don't carry weapons.
2177 You guys don't stab people. You guys haven't shot none of us."
2178

2179 Q: Okay. So, yeah, I see 'cause now your next comment is kinda laughing again,
2180 "Ha. Ha. Ha. You all fight with no weapons and no knives. You're all some
2181 fake ass niggahs." So in your estimation if somebody does not fight with a
2182 gun or a knife they are not a real gangster?
2183

2184 A: Well, I seen real gangsters in Cali. When I was down there.
2185

2186 Q: Okay.
2187

2188 A: They would always have either a gun or a knife.
2189

2190 Q: Okay.
2191

2192 A: And then whenever I hear about it they're always like, "Yeah whenever we
2193 rumble we always have knife or a gun, you know, just in case."
2194

2195 Q: Okay.
2196

2197 A: And I was like, "Oh, I see." And then these - they're - whenever they want to
2198 rumble it was like, "No guns, no knives, just fists. If you guys use knives and
2199 guns you guys are pussies." So I was like, no 'cause I know original
2200 gangsters. They would take a life for it. They don't care.
2201

2202 Q: So do you feel that if these individuals are not fighting with guns and knives
2203 that they weren't really gangsters?
2204

2205 A: 'Cause like sometimes I know how they act.

2206
2207 Q: Mm-hm.
2208
2209 A: Like they're always cocky but then when it comes down to it they never show
2210 up. I know that - I know a few people back in Cali. When I was down there
2211 they would always make up a plan. They would definitely show up.
2212
2213 Q: Sure.
2214
2215 A: They would definitely show up. They would definitely come with anybody.
2216 So it's people in the gang and they won't say number they're the best. It
2217 doesn't matter how tough you are if you more member then you're the best. If
2218 you have more knives or guns you're basically the best too. And I was like -
2219 'cause they - they fight - they fight like little numbers but then it's always -
2220 they never pick on us. They always pick on the little kids.
2221
2222 A: And then all the people down there they call it fists. I was like, "Oh, that's
2223 pretty okay, but-" and then these people are all claiming that they're true
2224 gangsters. I was like I seen true gangsters. They carry guns. They don't care
2225 who - who you are. If you have a different color shirt on they'll shoot you.
2226
2227 Q: Did you feel like a real gangster this evening when you had a knife and were
2228 confronting (Isaiah)?
2229
2230 A: I hadn't done it. I hadn't done it.
2231
2232 Q: I'm not suggesting you did. I was...
2233
2234 A: Well...
2235
2236 Q: ...I'm sorry...
2237
2238 A: ...no...
2239
2240 Q: ...you had problems like this.
2241
2242 A: No. I had this relocation and like I seen real gangsters. They stab you. They
2243 think that it's all cool but when I did it I felt really bad and then - I ain't never
2244 considered myself as a true gangster 'cause right now I was just really tense
2245 and I...
2246
2247 Q: Sure.
2248
2249 A: ...wasn't (unintelligible) whatever.
2250

2251 Q: Yeah. I see in - in - now in, ah, (Isaiah)'s next, ah, post he makes some racial
2252 slurs.
2253
2254 A: Yeah, and I was like, "You're being racist on me."
2255
2256 Q: Yeah. Um, let me see here. Um, you kind of called him out on talking tough
2257 behind a screen and acting hard.
2258
2259 A: Yeah, I was like, "Come to say it in my face."
2260
2261 Q: "Come say it to my face." So I guess it kinda goes back to my earlier question.
2262 Were - were you expecting (Isaiah) to come to your house because it - it
2263 almost sounds like you're - you're telling him, "Come and say it to my face."
2264
2265 A: I was. To be honest I was but I was acting out whatever.
2266
2267 Q: Okay.
2268
2269 A: Because after that I know that he didn't answer back.
2270
2271 Q: Okay.
2272
2273 A: I stayed on there.
2274
2275 Q: So you were expecting him or you weren't expecting him?
2276
2277 A: I wasn't expecting him 'cause I know that he's not gonna show up.
2278
2279 Q: Okay.
2280
2281 A: And then...
2282
2283 Q: Well he said, "Where are you at?"
2284
2285 A: Yeah and I was like, "Yeah. I'm at home."
2286
2287 Q: Not like he didn't respond to you.
2288
2289 A: No, after that. Like at the bottom. I was like, "Yeah," and he didn't say
2290 anything back.
2291
2292 Q: Okay. 'Cause you told him where you were, right?
2293
2294 A: Then he was like...
2295

2296 Q: Actually you told him inaccurate information. You said, "I'm at my
2297 homeboy's crib."
2298

2299 A: Well I just said that 'cause I wanted him to actually come and find me 'cause I
2300 know people who know where I live and that...
2301

2302 Q: Okay.
2303

2304 A: ...they bang for GD. They used to.
2305

2306 Q: Okay.
2307

2308 A: I mean they still talk to 'em. So I was like I'm suggesting that he knows where
2309 I live, so...
2310

2311 Q: Okay. I'm getting the sense that you're not really telling me the whole scope
2312 of your gang involvement and that's why I'm asking a couple of questions.
2313

2314 A: Well...
2315

2316 Q: I just want to make sure I understand and I - and I think you helped me really
2317 understand a lot of the scenario so far but now I - I want to understand why
2318 this happened and I think we're kind of tip-toeing around that a little bit. And
2319 what I'm telling you is it's not against the law to be in a gang...
2320

2321 A: Well...
2322

2323 Q: ...you know, but it's...
2324

2325 A: Um, at first it was me messaging my nephew.
2326

2327 Q: Okay.
2328

2329 A: And I was like, "So what there's gonna be a rumble?" And I was like, "Who's
2330 all gonna be there?" He was like, "I don't know but we're probably not gonna
2331 have enough." I was like, "I could see if I could make it just to watch and help
2332 you out if anything happens."
2333

2334 Q: Okay.
2335

2336 A: And he was like, "Yeah, that's fine." I was like, "I'll back you on it. How
2337 much do you - how much guys you think are going?" I was like, "Ten or
2338 fifteen." And then one of the GD guys were at - were messaging. It was like,
2339 "You guys goin' to the rumble?" I was like, "I don't know." And he was like,
2340 "Oh, well it's a fair fight." I was like, "It is?" And he was like, "Yeah. I'm

2341 gonna go ahead and go watch.” And I was like, “Oh, okay.”
2342
2343 Q: And that was a rumble for tonight?
2344
2345 A: Yeah a rumble for tonight.
2346
2347 Q: And where was that rumble to take place?
2348
2349 A: Marathon. And then after that I was like, “Oh, that’s cool.”
2350
2351 Q: What time was that supposed to take place at?
2352
2353 A: Seven. Seven or something, or five. Whatever.
2354
2355 Q: At Marathon Park?
2356
2357 A: Yeah. I heard that it was seven.
2358
2359 Q: So you were having this conversation with one of these GD kids?
2360
2361 A: Yeah the guy was asking me if I was gonna rumble and I was like, “I don’t
2362 know.” If they’re gonna outnumbered I’m gonna go with your boys to just to
2363 check it out.
2364
2365 Q: Okay. Now when you say GD, are we talking about (Isaiah)’s group - is that a
2366 gang...
2367
2368 A: That’s a gang too.
2369
2370 Q: As far as you know is that a gang he’s affiliated with?
2371
2372 A: Yeah.
2373
2374 Q: Are you familiar with YRS at all?
2375
2376 A: I know that name. I don’t know who’s all in there though.
2377
2378 Q: Okay.
2379
2380 A: It a Young Ruthless Squad or something like that.
2381
2382 Q: Okay. Is (Isaiah) part of that?
2383
2384 A: Think so. I don’t know.
2385

2386 Q: Okay. Is that a GD - are they a GD set as far as you know?
2387
2388 A: I think they - well I think YRS branched off of GD.
2389
2390 Q: Okay.
2391
2392 A: So.
2393
2394 Q: So who is the - who is the GD member that you were having a conversation
2395 with about this rumble at Marathon Park?
2396
2397 A: (Cody Williams).
2398
2399 Q: Okay.
2400
2401 A: And then he was like acting all cocky and I got pissed off so that's when I
2402 started saying all this shit. And then after that - after that, ah, we were like all
2403 his people. And then 'cause he had tagged me - tagged me in his status. He
2404 was like, "Who ever had this niggah added call out his name."
2405
2406 Q: Okay.
2407
2408 A: And then (Cody) commented, "You're all a fake gang." And they're calling
2409 me pussy and shit.
2410
2411 Q: Okay.
2412
2413 A: I got more ticked off about it whatever.
2414
2415 Q: Okay.
2416
2417 A: And then after that all these guys were messaging me saying that they're
2418 gonna - saying if I see or if I set the fight's at five or seven. I was like, yeah, I
2419 frickin do. OTB.
2420
2421 Q: Okay. Okay. So you're telling all these guys that you're part of OTB.
2422
2423 A: Mm-hm.
2424
2425 Q: But as we sit here and talk it's - it's like you're telling me you're not part of
2426 OTB.
2427
2428 A: I'm not - well...
2429
2430 Q: I'm trying to figure out what the real Dylan here is.

2431
2432 A: To be honest, yeah, I guess I am OTB.
2433
2434 Q: Okay.
2435
2436 A: I just didn't want to get in trouble for being in one.
2437
2438 Man: Sorry to interrupt. Do you have like two minutes?
2439
2440 Q: I do.
2441
2442 Man: Okay.
2443
2444 Q: Well that helps me understand that part of it.
2445
2446 Man: Actually I wanted to - you guys were up in your bedroom?
2447
2448 A: Mm-hm.
2449
2450 Man: And what were you doing up in the bedroom before this all happened?
2451
2452 A: We were just sitting there talking listening to music.
2453
2454 Man: Was anybody on a computer or using their phones, or...
2455
2456 A: I was using my phone.
2457
2458 Man: On Facebook or...
2459
2460 A: Yeah I was.
2461
2462 Man: With (Isaiah)?
2463
2464 A: Yeah.
2465
2466 Man: Okay. And that was all on your phone. Was there any computer or laptop or
2467 anything up in your room?
2468
2469 A: No.
2470
2471 Man: No. Do you mind just to verify do you - would you give us consent to go up
2472 into your bedroom at your house just to look and verify there's no computer or
2473 laptop or anything like that up there that was being used?
2474
2475 A: I guess...

2476
2477 Man: I mean you got any problems with that?
2478
2479 A: I kinda do but...
2480
2481 Man: Is there somethin' up there you don't want us to see or what?
2482
2483 A: No it's just my personal stuff.
2484
2485 Man: Just your personal stuff? Okay. Um...
2486
2487 A: 'Cause I mean I do have a laptop but it doesn't work. It's very slow.
2488
2489 Man: Okay.
2490
2491 A: So I don't use that at all. Since I have a phone I just use my phone all the time.
2492
2493 Man: Sure. And that's understandable.
2494
2495 A: Yeah, I don't - I don't touch laptops. I only use phones.
2496
2497 Man: Do your mom or dad go in your room?
2498
2499 A: Ah, sometimes they do, but whenever they do it's always messy.
2500
2501 Man: It's what?
2502
2503 A: Always messy.
2504
2505 Man: Always messy?
2506
2507 A: Yeah.
2508
2509 Man: But your mom and dad have free reign to go in your room? I mean they can
2510 go in and out as they please or do they have to check with you first?
2511
2512 A: Well they don't - they don't really go through my stuff. They go in see - see
2513 what's in there, like see if I'm in there or not and then they would walk back
2514 out 'cause I'm not (unintelligible).
2515
2516 Man: Do you share your room at all or is it just your room?
2517
2518 A: Just my room.
2519
2520 Man: Okay.

2521
2522 A: I used to with my older brother but since my step-brother moved out and my
2523 brother moved into his room and then we put the two beds - the two beds
2524 together.
2525
2526 Man: Okay. Well like I said, we just want to verify because that's similar to what
2527 (Joe) was sayin' is that you guys were up there listening to music, um, and we
2528 just want to verify that's what that looks like up there, that's what you guys
2529 were doin'. Um, so I guess I'm asking for your consent for - for them to go up
2530 there, um, and just look around in there. It would be that detective that was
2531 over there in your house talking to your mom.
2532
2533 A: Yeah, that's fine.
2534
2535 Man: Can you say that a little louder. I'm not sure your...
2536
2537 A: I guess that's fine.
2538
2539 Man: You guess that's fine. Okay. Um, okay. They'll talk to your parents about this
2540 also, okay? Thank you.
2541
2542 Q: Um, now you said some of these GD guys started messaging you and asking
2543 you certain things here.
2544
2545 A: Uh-huh.
2546
2547 Q: Was one of them a (CJ)?
2548
2549 A: (CJ)?
2550
2551 Q: Yeah. Does that name sound familiar?
2552
2553 A: Yeah.
2554
2555 Q: Okay.
2556
2557 A: He was the one who was there too.
2558
2559 Q: Okay.
2560
2561 A: At the stabbing.
2562
2563 Q: Okay. So you think he was in the vehicle? You saw him there in veh...
2564
2565 A: Yeah.

2566
2567 Q: Okay.
2568
2569 A: 'Cause he said he was gonna come and beat my ass with a (unintelligible)
2570 whatever.
2571
2572 Q: Okay. So at some point he messages you and you respond, um, something
2573 about you're gonna mess with my nephew. Is this reference maybe this fight
2574 or somethin' comin' up.
2575
2576 A: Yeah. He was there 'cause (CJ) he wanted to jump - he wanted to rumble with
2577 my nephew.
2578
2579 Q: Oh, okay.
2580
2581 A: Yeah, that's why. I messaged him. I was like, "So you gonna rumble with my
2582 nephew?" And I was like, "You gonna bring GD up here as well too?"
2583
2584 Q: So and just let me know if this sounds like a conversation you had with him
2585 earlier. Um - um, were you saying this kind of stuff. Words like, "Fuck your
2586 clique niggah. OTB gang bitch. What's up bitch?"
2587
2588 A: Yeah.
2589
2590 Q: So that's...
2591
2592 A: My words.
2593
2594 Q: Okay. So that's - that's - that's you saying that, right?
2595
2596 A: Yeah.
2597
2598 Q: And then he responds, "YRS to the grave niggah shut up."
2599
2600 A: "YRS to the grave niggah shut up."
2601
2602 Q: Okay and so your - oops sorry. Your response to that is a kind of question
2603 like, "YRS? Some newbie ass fuckers. YRSK bitch." That sound familiar?
2604
2605 A: Mm-hm.
2606
2607 Q: "Wait 'til we catch you slippin'." So what do you - what does that mean?
2608
2609 A: Like wait 'til we see you.
2610

2611 Q: Okay.
2612
2613 A: Wait 'til you do something.
2614
2615 Q: Okay. And then what?
2616
2617 A: And that's why we jump a guy.
2618
2619 Q: Okay.
2620
2621 A: Yeah.
2622
2623 Q: So you were plannin' on jumpin' these guys?
2624
2625 A: They never show up anyways. Like whenever - 'cause they like - we always
2626 play each other but we don't do anything. That's why.
2627
2628 Q: Okay.
2629
2630 A: None of us hasn't done anything since seventh grade.
2631
2632 Q: Okay. But here we are.
2633
2634 A: Yeah. But he react now 'cause they actually showed up. They were actually
2635 down close where we live when we're talking. I was like, "OTB ACK and
2636 IB." They were like, "We're gonna show you this time."
2637
2638 Q: For somebody who's not in a gang it sounds a lot like you're in a gang, you
2639 know. I mean I'm not a genius or anything but that's what it sounds like to
2640 me.
2641
2642 A: Yeah. I told you I am in.
2643
2644 Q: Okay.
2645
2646 A: I'm still in OTB. I was - I quit but then I wanted back in so...
2647
2648 Q: Why did you want back in?
2649
2650 A: Because I wanted backup 'cause when I quit I didn't have anybody - 'cause
2651 like when I quit that was when they were still (unintelligible) so I want to join
2652 again and they're - that's when they stopped talking.
2653
2654 Q: Okay.
2655

2656 A: And then now since they're always like, "Oh OTB Killer." I was like, "Oh
2657 you guys aren't true killers." Like I've I seen true killersss...
2658

2659 Q: So, (Joe) is part of this. (Troy)'s part of this. What are their street names just
2660 so I keep them straight?
2661

2662 A: Um, (Joe) is (Mojo).
2663

2664 Q: (Mojo), okay. Makes sense. I can see that.
2665

2666 A: Yeah.
2667

2668 Q: Yeah.
2669

2670 A: And then (Troy)'s (Little T).
2671

2672 Q: (Little T). Okay.
2673

2674 A: Like (Little Troy).
2675

2676 Q: Okay. And you're (Little G) for like gangster? Something like that?
2677

2678 A: I don't know I was...
2679

2680 Q: So who are some of the other guys now that are involved in this with you?
2681

2682 A: Um, so - what OTB?
2683

2684 Q: Yeah. It's not just you three, right? It's just you three?
2685

2686 A: No.
2687

2688 Q: All right.
2689

2690 A: But...
2691

2692 Q: Okay. Who else is involved?
2693

2694 A: Um...
2695

2696 Q: I mean you gave me some names before, (Boner), (Sparker), (Big D). Those
2697 guys still? They don't (unintelligible). Those are older guys, all right.
2698

2699 A: They're like 20, 21.
2700

2701 Q: Yeah they're all - I've known (Lao Xiong) for a long time.
2702
2703 A: Yeah.
2704
2705 Q: Okay.
2706
2707 A: Yeah.
2708
2709 Q: I've known all these guys for a long time.
2710
2711 A: Yeah. Those were the guys wearing OTB.
2712
2713 Q: So are guys that are doin' that with you now, that are claimingg in OTB now?
2714
2715 A: Um, what if I tell you their names. Are they gonna get in trouble?
2716
2717 Q: No. Like I - it's not against the law to be in a gang. I'm just - I kinda like to
2718 know because if somethin' like this happens again...
2719
2720 A: Oh.
2721
2722 Q: ...I want to head this stuff off before things like this happen and kind of the
2723 picture that you're painting here for me, or in this case drawing for me, tells
2724 me that, at least to a certain degree, it sounds like there was some friction
2725 between these two groups that were kinda rival groups. What helps...
2726
2727 ((Crosstalk))
2728
2729 Q: ...what helps me - well I understand...
2730
2731 A: Yeah.
2732
2733 Q: ...but two groups that were kinda talkin' smack back and forth. What helps me
2734 to - to maybe prevent some of this stuff from happening in the future is to
2735 really know who's involved with all these groups so we can maybe try to head
2736 off some of this stuff before somebody gets hurt or somebody drives down a
2737 street with a, you know, an Airsoft gun or somebody grabs a knife or
2738 somethin' like that. You know what I'm sayin'? So that - that's really the
2739 main reason of why I would be interested in that information. I'm not looking
2740 to go, you know, pick - I'm not gonna get any - try to get anybody in trouble
2741 just because they wear a red 49ers jacket or have red shoes, or you know, like
2742 the color red for that matter, or have a street name. But it - it's helpful for me.
2743 It - it's helpful to know who - who the individuals are 'cause I don't want
2744 anybody to get hurt anymore, all right? You seem like a nice guy, Dylan. You
2745 seem like you don't want anybody to get hurt. You've told me that, you know,

2746 right away you realized like, "Oh crap this wasn't a good thing." Um, and I -
2747 and I think you're sincere about that, you know. Um, we have an opportunity
2748 here to maybe prevent some - some other stuff from happening, you know?
2749
2750 A: Well the guys that I usually kicked it were (Mushu).
2751
2752 Q: Okay.
2753
2754 A: (Zay).
2755
2756 Q: Who?
2757
2758 A: (Mushu).
2759
2760 Q: Okay. (Zay).
2761
2762 A: Yeah. (Zay).
2763
2764 Q: Do you know his real name?
2765
2766 A: Uh-uh. I don't even ask them for their real names.
2767
2768 Q: Okay.
2769
2770 A: And then there was (Prince). And then I kick it with a guy that used to be
2771 OTB.
2772
2773 Q: Okay.
2774
2775 A: Ah, (Toby).
2776
2777 Q: Do you know (Toby)'s real name or is that his real name?
2778
2779 A: No. I don't know. I haven't asked - I only ask them for names. I always call
2780 them by the street name.
2781
2782 Q: Sure.
2783
2784 A: 'Cause, yeah, we don't really call each other by real names 'cause I don't
2785 know why. But - oh yeah (unintelligible) call me (Little G) or call me brother,
2786 I mean. And there is (Bee)...
2787
2788 Q: What's his last name?
2789
2790 A: Yang.

2791
2792 Q: He's a Yang just like your cousin was?
2793
2794 A: Yeah, he's my cousin.
2795
2796 Q: Is (Mushu) your cousin also?
2797
2798 A: Mm-hm.
2799
2800 Q: Is he in a gang or something?
2801
2802 A: (Unintelligible).
2803
2804 Q: Okay. (Prince) is a Yang also, right?
2805
2806 A: I think so. I think he's a - he's either a Yang or a (unintelligible).
2807
2808 Q: Okay. All right. So (Bee) Yang. Who else?
2809
2810 A: Um, those are the only people that I usually kick with.
2811
2812 Q: Okay.
2813
2814 A: Everybody else that I know (Mushu)'s been telling me that they're either
2815 locked up or they live all around the country, so.
2816
2817 Q: Okay. So who's like the shot caller of OTB right now in your area?
2818
2819 A: Nobody's shotcaller all because it's one man for ourselves.
2820
2821 Q: Okay. What's the point then?
2822
2823 A: Just - we're just homeys. We got each other's backs.
2824
2825 Q: Okay.
2826
2827 A: You know.
2828
2829 Q: All right.
2830
2831 A: We don't force people to do it.
2832
2833 Q: Sure.
2834
2835 A: (Unintelligible)

2836
2837 Q: Sure. Okay. Are you still doin' okay. Can I get you anything else to drink? Do
2838 you need to use a restroom, anything like that?
2839
2840 A: Yeah.
2841
2842 Q: Yeah. Bathroom? Sure.
2843
2844 A: So how long do you think we're gonna stay in here.
2845
2846 Q: I don't know. I'm gonna try to get that answer for you real soon. Actually, let
2847 me ask - Yeah, we'll go, ah, use the restroom. Right turn. It's hot in here. I'll
2848 grab you some water. If he wants he can doodle. Let me fill this guy up for
2849 you. Hang tight a second okay?
2850
2851 A: Okay.
2852
2853 Q: Be right back with you.
2854
2855 Man: You want some food (unintelligible).
2856
2857 Q: Hey, Dylan. Sorry. Oh look at you, man. They hooked you up with some food.
2858
2859 A: Yeah.
2860
2861 Q: Right on. Hey can you do me a favor. I need to take a picture of the bottom of
2862 your shoes. We just saw several footprints in the snow and I just want to try to
2863 figure out like who's who. All right. Let's see here. Let me see the other one
