PARK SHELTER INFORMATION

Park shelters are provided in both Wausau and Marathon County parks for the comfort of our visitors. See back for shelters that can be reserved on-line.

Most shelters are classified as the "open" type; these are roofed structures, open on three or more sides, and usually provided with a concrete slab and picnic tables. Open shelters in Marathon Park, Big Eau Pleine Park, Bluegill Bay Park, Dells of the Eau Claire Park, and Mission Lake Park, may be reserved for a fee. Open shelters in all other City or County parks are not reservable, and have no fee for their use.

"Enclosed" shelters are those which are totally or partially enclosed and locked. These buildings can be reserved for parties or groups. All enclosed shelters have water and restrooms inside or nearby.

Some enclosed shelters are provided with stovetops and refrigerators, and most have fireplaces. Several shelters have spacious, open wings which more than double the capacity of the building.

County shelters are massive but graceful blends of natural stone foundations and log superstructures. City shelters are combinations of stonework and rough-hewn timbers. All shelters add charm and elegance to an outing, besides guaranteeing protection from poor weather. Most shelters have ample parking space close by.

Facility and shelter Reservations will be accepted up to one year in advance of your event date. Reservations can be made on-line, over the phone or in person at the Park Office.

The key/security/tent deposit will be returned in full provided the building has been secured and left in good condition and all tents, temporary structures and equipment have been removed by closing time on the last day of the rental. The user is expected to clear and clean the shelter after use immediately following the scheduled event. When cleaning an enclosed shelter - floors must be swept, tables washed, and trash bagged and deposited in outside bins.

All park buildings and areas have maximum capacities set by safety code regulations, planned seating capacities, and parking provisions. The Park Commission reserves the right to deny any application.

Staff is available by appointment to view enclosed shelters prior to reservation/event.
