WATER QUALITY TESTING IS NOT PERFORMED AT THIS BEACH

THE PUBLIC IS ADVISED THAT HEAVY RAINFALL MAY RESULT IN RUNOFF FROM NEARBY LAND CAUSING AN UNSAFE LEVEL OF BACTERIA TO BE PRESENT IN THE WATER FOR A PERIOD OF 24 - 48 HOURS.

WATER THAT IS CLOUDY, LOOKS LIKE GREEN PAINT OR PEA SOUP OR HAS FLOATING CLUMPS MAY CONTAIN BLUE-GREEN ALGAE CAPABLE OF PRODUCING TOXINS THAT CAN BE DANGEROUS TO HUMANS AND PETS.

IF THESE CONDITIONS EXIST, YOU WOULD BE ADVISED NOT TO SWIM IN THE WATER, ALLOW CHILDREN TO PLAY IN THE WATER, OR ALLOW PETS TO SWIM IN OR DRINK THE WATER.

IT IS ALWAYS RECOMMENDED TO RINSE AND TOWEL OFF AFTER SWIMMING.
